

E-bike Trips





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


Highlights Verbier - Zermatt

"A concentration of the most beautiful trails, the most alpine landscapes and the most typical accommodation. A pearl of the Alps!"

- Spend a night in a charming hotel perched on a pan oramic promontory in front of the sublime 4'000.
- Ride and admire one of the most emblematic mountains in the world, the Matterhorn.
- Enjoy a lunch break and taste Alpine cheeses and home-made dried meat in front of the 4'000 of the Valais.
- Sip a cold beer in a jacuzzi at 2'000 metres after a day full of magnificent singletrails.

Location & Access



You can reach Verbier by car, train or plane via Geneva or Sion.

By road, Verbier is 20 min. from Martigny, 50 min. from Sion, 2h. from Geneva and 1h30 from Chamonix.



Dates & Program

You can choose the date that suits you between June 28 and September 12.

The stays start on Sunday at the end of the day (arrival at the hotel) and end on Saturday morning after breakfast. The typical program that we present can be adapted or modified according to your wishes.





Day 1: Arrival in Verbier, get ready for your adventure.

Arrival in Verbier and preperation for your trip with your guides.

Day 2: Secret singletrails and a charming historic hotel

The journey begins with a nice descent on a flow trail that takes us to the Tzoumaz. After a good warm-up, you are ready to ride on an incredible alpine ridge. Sublime :).

Then, after crossing a forest we will arrive at Mandelon and you will get to know the famous Hérens cows. A balcony path will take us to a hidden pearl of the region. A sublime single-trail that is both rolling and playful. Pow pow pow! It's time to let the horses loose. Forest roads will then take us to the unspoilt village of La Sage facing the impressive "Dent Blanche", a peak of 4'357 metres. It's time to have a brandy and relax in one of the sofas of our historic hotel dating back to 1890 while the chef puts his French touch to the fresh products of the region.

Accent (D+): 2'600m.

Distance: 68km

Technical difficulty: 2 à 3


Day 3: A sublime alpine pass at 2900 metres and a historic hotel perched in the middle of the 4000

This morning don't forget to take a full breakfast. The first ascent of the day takes us to an incredible pass at 2'900 metres. The climb is a real challenge. However, most of it can be done on your e-bike! The descent is worth your effort. A rolling alpine singletrail with an incredible view of the 4'000 as well as two sublime mountain lakes of immaculate blue. Welcome to an alpine paradise. After a playful descent into the valley, our final ascent leads us to a pearl of the Swiss Alps: a hotel perched on a magnificent plateau with a panoramic view of the 4'000. Magical. The best possible after-ride terrace!

D+: 2'350m.

Distance: 40km

Technical difficutly: 2 à 3







Day 4: An epic day rewarded with a wellness evening at 2000 metres

Open your eyes wide...and prepare yourself for a new day that will remain engraved in your memories. Flowy and playful singletrails down to the valley. Warm up your brakes and bring out the smile! A little shuttle and we find ourselves once again perched on a plateau overlooking the valley.

The rest is a series of sublime flowy "Wanderweg". And yes, we have arrived in the German-speaking part of Switzerland. With such paths, you will start to enjoy the climb :). Your day will end in a private alpine hut at 2'000 meters. Tonight, get your swimsuit ready for a unique combination of jacuzzi, sauna and the most famous local dish, fondue!

Breathe...you're not dreaming.

D+: 1'600m.

Distance: 45km

Technical difficulties: 2 à 3

Jour 5: Un chemin en balcon et l'arrivée à zermatt, au pied du Cervin

After breakfast at 2'000 metres, the last day of e-bike starts with a magnificent trail with a panoramic view of the 4'000 of the Zermatt valley. Another flowy singletrail takes us back down into the valley. We then ride up the Zermatt valley to discover the last pearls of our stay. Beautiful rolling trails in front of the most mythical mountain in the world :). Don't forget your camera, the panorama is sumptuous. We end our adventure in a hotel with spa in front of the Matterhorn. Take the time to relax your muscles by reminiscing about the incredible days you experienced during your trip.

D+: 1'800m.

Distance: 45km

Technical difficulties: 2 à 3

Day 6: One last coffee in Zermatt

All good things come to an end. After a final morning rest or visit to Zermatt, the time has come to prepare your affairs. We'll take you back to Verbier before wishing you a safe journey home with memories full of an incredible alpine adventure!

Equipment

The rental of an E-Bike and a helmet is included in the price of your package.

For your comfort, we recommend that you arrive with the following equipment

- Sneakers suitable for walking in the mountains
- Cycling shorts or shorts with reinforcement
- Cycling gloves
- Sunglasses
- a small backpack to carry some clothes (against cold and rain) with Camelbak compartment
- A Camelbak should your backpack not have one



Price

CHF 1'990.- /pers

These prices include:

- Accommodation in a double room with ½ board, 5 nights
- Rental of the electric mountain bike for 6 days
- Supervision by a mountain bike guide
- Transportation (lifts, bus, public transport, etc.)

These prices do not include:

- Drinks
- Lunches and dinners in the mountains (restaurants, mountain huts, alpine pastures, etc.)
- Accommodation in a single room (Details in "Accommodation")
- Personal expenses at the hotel (mini-bar, laundry, etc.)
- Your access travel to Verbier



Registration & Payment

In order to register, you must first inform us of the chosen date.

If the guide and the hotel you have chosen are available, we will send you by e-mail a registration form and the invoice for your stay. To confirm your reservation, you will have to send us back your registration form and proceed to the payment of the deposit (35% of the amount of the stay).

Cancellation insurance:

A cancellation and repatriation insurance is mandatory. If you do not have insurance covering this risk, we can advise you of companies that offer this type of insurance:

Mondial assistance - Carnet voyage ETI from TCS - Axa, Travel insurance - etc.

Payment method:

- 35% upon reservation
- 35% 60 day before your departure
- The balance 30 days before departure

Payments are made by bank transfer in €uro or CHF according to the chosen destination.

Cancellation:

In case of cancellation of your stay the deposit is not refunded. They will be carried over to a later reservation only if we have been able to resell your place.

In case of cancellation 60 days or less before your departure, the deposit and the balance of your stay will be refunded only if your place could be resold.
